Expected Levels for *most* children in Key Stage 2

Any child coming into Junior Education with a level 2c or above is expected to make 12 points increase over the 4 years of junior education. At Raglan, we set challenging targets of 14 points progress over 4 years. Educational development and progress are rarely linear - pupils will work within, below, above and around a level over time: they are not absolute. For example, a child on a 3c may be working at level 3b or 3a and still be working within some areas of a 2a - this is especially true in English and slightly less so in mathematics.

If a child leaves year 2 with a 2c (15 points), the national expectation would be to leave Y6 12 points further on a 4c (27 points). At Raglan, we would be setting targets to maximise development and aim for a 4b or 14 points.

If a child has Special Needs, progress is likely to be measured in smaller steps using P-scales or small-step progress - these are shared with parents and pupils alike. Conversely, if a child is identified as highly able, they may make much greater progress.

2 levels progress. The Department for Children, Schools and Families now measure 2 levels progress across the key stage. Thus, if a child comes to Juniors on a level 1 they should leave with a level 3 by the end of Y6; arriving with a level 2 in year 3 and leaving with a level 4 and arriving with a level 3 and leaving with a level 5 - **sub levels are now much less used**. A useful indicator is making two levels progress over Ys3-6 in English and mathematics.
